ARRIVALS TO THE VILLA AT BORGO CASTELLENGO

TIME AT LEISURE

Settle into the 8,000-square-foot villa as you explore its exceptional spaces—five elegantly appointed bedrooms, a charming courtyard and beautiful gardens, a heated saltwater pool, wine cellar, indoor and outdoor dining rooms, a fully equipped kitchen, a stocked bar, inviting living and sitting areas, a well-appointed gym, and even a private cinema. As aperitivo hour approaches, unwind beneath vine-draped pergolas, savoring the local tradition while taking in sweeping views of the Alta Langa hills.

DINNER AT OSTERIA DELL'ARCO

Enjoy dinner at one of Alba's most beloved traditional restaurants located in the heart of the historic center. The menu features local specialties such as handmade Tjarin pasta, Agnolotti del Plin, and Vitello Tonnato. Complemented by a well-curated wine list highlighting producers from the Langhe, the experience is relaxed yet refined.

BREAKFAST AT THE VILLA AND ENJOY THE MORNING AT YOUR LEISURE

EXPLORE CASTELLO DI GRINZANE CAVOUR

Visit Castello di Grinzane Cavour, one of the most important landmarks in the Langhe wine region and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Dating back to the 13th century, the castle is home to the fascinating Langhe Museum, where exhibits explore the history, culture, and centuries-old winemaking traditions. Stroll through the castle grounds, which offer sweeping views of vine-covered hills, historic villages, and the surrounding countryside.

For lunch, enjoy a refined Piedmontese meal at Ristorante Grinzane Cavour.

STOP IN LA MORRA

Take in the sweeping panoramic views from the Belvedere viewpoint, often described as an “open-air map” of the Langhe. The vantage point offers a striking perspective on the Barolo wine region’s unique geography, where each slope and exposure contributes to the character of the wines produced below.

VISIT POLLENZO AND AGENZIA DI POLLENZO

Pollenzo, an ancient town of Roman origin, is home to the historic Agenzia di Pollenzo. Once the private residence of King Carlo Alberto of Savoy, it was restored in 2004 and now houses the University of Gastronomic Sciences and the Wine Bank. Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997, the royal estate offers a striking blend of history, architecture, and gastronomy.

DINNER AT PIAZZA DUOMO

Enjoy an unforgettable dinner at Piazza Duomo, a three-Michelin-star and Michelin Green Star restaurant in the heart of Alba. Led by acclaimed chef Enrico Crippa, the restaurant is celebrated for its highly creative, seasonally driven cuisine, with a particular focus on vegetables, herbs, and flowers sourced from its own gardens.

Continue your visit with a trip to **WiMu Wine Museum**, an immersive experience that brings the history, culture, and evolution of Barolo wine to life through interactive and multimedia exhibits.

LUNCH AT RISTORANTE ALL'ENOTECA IN CANALE

Enjoy a leisurely Michelin-starred lunch at Ristorante All'Enoteca, one of the region's most acclaimed dining destinations. Under the guidance of Chef Davide Palluda, traditional Langhe flavors are transformed into refined and inventive dishes that showcase the finest seasonal ingredients.

TRUFFLE HUNTING

DINNER AT IL RISTORANTE DI GUIDO DA COSTIGLIOLE

Enjoy dinner at the Michelin-starred Guido da Costigliole, set within the beautifully restored cellars of a former 17th-century monastery. The restaurant offers an elegant interpretation of Piedmontese cuisine through carefully curated tasting menus honoring the legendary culinary heritage of the Alciati family.
